Dr. Jordan Brasher is an Assistant Professor of Geography in the Department of History & Geography. After receiving his B.S. degree from Middle Tennessee State University and his M.S. degree from Oklahoma State University, Dr. Brasher completed his Ph.D. in Geography at the University of Tennessee.

Since joining the Columbus State University Faculty in 2020, Dr. Brasher has instructed courses in World Regional Geography and Introductory, Intermediate and Advanced courses in Geographic Information Systems (GIS). He also oversees the GIS Certificate Program, and is a Research Fellow with Tourism RESET, a multi-university interdisciplinary initiative to identify, study, and challenge inequality in the tourism industry. His research focuses on the memorialization of slavery and settler colonialism in the Americas, especially in the United States and Brazil. His work has appeared in peer reviewed journals such as *Social & Cultural Geography*, *The Journal of Heritage Tourism*, and *Memory Studies*, as well as news outlets such as *The Washington Post*.

Dr. Patrick Jackson is a Professor of English in the Department of English. Dr. Patrick Jackson joined the CSU Faculty in 2008, a year after completing his Ph.D. at the University of Oregon. Since then, he has taught a wide variety of courses and topics, including classes on modern poetry, First World War literature, Nigerian literature, the poetry of Emily Dickinson, the detective novel, and J.RR. Tolkien's *The Lord of the Rings*.

For his teaching, he has won the Outstanding Teaching of Writing Award and the Honors College Award for Excellence in Teaching. He has taught study abroad programs multiple times, both in England and Italy, and he has been heavily involved in student-run organizations such as the university's student newspaper and CSU's English honors society, Sigma Tau Delta. He is currently finishing a two-year fellowship with the Honors College. In his research, Dr. Jackson has focused primarily on British poetry of the twentieth century, publishing on the works of Wilfred Owen, the works of Ted Hughes, and the history of blank verse. He was promoted to Professor of English in 2019.

Dr. Kerri Taylor is an Associate Professor of Organic Chemistry in the Department of Chemistry. Dr. Taylor obtained her Ph.D. in Chemistry from The University of Akron and M.S. in Chemistry from The University of Kentucky.

While at Columbus State University, Dr.Taylor has supervised at least 21 undergraduate students and 3 graduate students. Of those 24 students, 75% identify as minority or under-represented groups. She has a broad knowledge and varied skill set in the field of synthetic medicinal chemistry and material science, which enables her to be a significant contributor in the scientific community. Her exposure to multiple areas of chemistry, ranging from organic synthesis, drug efficacy, art restoration and material science, has led to strengthened synthetic skills and increased her chemical knowledge as an academic researcher.

Dr. Taylor has presented at more than 30 local, regional, and national scientific conferences and received the Young Chemist Committee (YCC) Leadership Development Award, Buchi 2020 Scholar Award, and Outstanding Faculty Award at The University of Akron. Dr. Taylor has also been a member of the American Chemical Society (ACS) and Georgia Academy of Science (GAS). As of 2022, she has published 8 peer-reviewed manuscripts/creative endeavors.

Calvin Bradford is pursuing a B.A. in Communication, and currently has a 4.0 GPA. In addition to being focused on achieving excellence in his educational career, Calvin is also a Sergeant First Class in the U.S. Army on active military duty. He has had several deployments in recent years while he was also earning an Associate degree in Small Group Management from Purdue Global. Calvin is a student leader in the Green to Gold program in CSU's ROTC program, and has proven his strong leadership skill in this and all facets of his life, career, and education. He is an active volunteer with Adopt a Space and a coach for the Columbus Youth Soccer Association. Calvin is also a serious scholar with a robust research program and he is enthusiastic when discussing his projects.

Sophia Brown will graduate in May with a perfect 4.0 GPA and three degrees: a Bachelor of Arts in History, and minors in Political Science and Sociology, as well as a certificate in International Studies. She is a member of CSU's Honors College and multiple honor societies, including Phi Kappa Phi, Phi Alpha Theta, and Pi Sigma Alpha. Sophia has received numerous state and university awards and scholarships for her research in the fields of both the Social Sciences and Humanities. She is extremely active in several CSU organizations, including Presidential Envoys and the Model U.N., and she is a Global Ambassador for the Center for Global Engagement. Sophia founded the student organization Cougars for Autonomy and Agency for All People, which works for universal social justice.

Sidney Ducleroir has maintained a 4.0 GPA while pursuing a Bachelor of Arts major in English with a focus on Literature, a minor degree in Theater Arts, and a certificate in Medieval and Renaissance Literature. Sidney has received numerous awards and honors, including invited presentations of her scholarship, and three Carson McCullers Literary Awards for her poetry and prose. She has been on the President's List for four years, and is a member of Sigma Tau Delta and Phi Kappa Phi honor societies. She is an active member of seven CSU organizations including The CSU Press, CSU's online student newspaper *The Uproar*, and the Creative Cougar Coalition, of which she is a founder and the current director. Following graduation, Sidney will be pursuing a doctoral degree in Medieval Literature and History.

Taylor Mattson currently has a 3.81 GPA, and will graduate in May from CSU's School of Nursing Prelicensure program with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing. She completed her first two years at CSU while still in high school through the Dual Enrollment program, and she maintained excellent grades in both schools despite the workload. She is a member of the Honors College, and has received multiple scholarships during her four years at CSU. Taylor has been an active member of the Student Nursing Association, serving as Vice President since 2020 and has proven her leadership abilities by directing meetings, establishing community service initiatives, and mentoring Junior Nursing students. Taylor is very active in Community Service and Leadership roles, and has contributed over 300 hours of volunteer work at Magnolia Manor Retirement Community.

Kyla Mims is pursuing a Bachelor of Science degree in Health Science, and is in the highly competitive Pre-Medical Studies program. Her goal is to become a physician. Kyla has a 4.0 GPA in her major and a 3.73 cumulative GPA. Kyla is a member of numerous organizations, including Honoris Causa, the National Society of Leadership and Success, the Georgia AHEC Scholars Program, and CSU Honors College. She is also a member of CSU's Camp P.R.O.W.L Team, which helps freshmen transition into the college setting. She has received numerous scholarships and awards, and has already been accepted into the Medical School of the Edward Via College of Osteopathic Medicine. As the Vice President of Presidential Envoys, Kyla works closely with President Markwood and Provost Bordelon to promote the mission of CSU and to assist with the university's improvement and advancement. In addition, Kyla is very involved in several medical organizations in Columbus, including Mercy Med, Piedmont Regional Hospitals, and American Family Care. In all of these capacities, Kyla assists the medical professionals with patient care in a variety of ways. She also works in the ER at Saint Francis Hospital as a medical scribe.
