Topic	Activity
Biology	Using microscopes to identify cells from the human body; touching reptiles
Chemistry	Creating fast and colorful chemical reactions
Computer Science	Testing the latest technology gadgets
Geology	Touching and identifying rocks of different origins
Physics	Discovering the properties of magnets, conductors, and sound waves
