- Official transcript(s)
- Immunization Record
- A form of lawful presence
- Some programs may require standardized test scores

How to Apply to CSU

Step 1

Complete Your Application

Submit the online graduate application and pay the non-refundable application fee of \$50. The fee is waived for returning CSU graduate students and students who earned a bachelor's degree or higher from CSU.

Submit Transcripts and Test Scores

Send official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended. Submit GRE, GMAT, MAT, GACE or other required test scores that your desired program requires.
