In order to transfer to Columbus State University, you must:

- [Submit an application to CSU](#)
- Pay a \$40 non-refundable application fee
- Submit your official transcript(s) from ALL prior attended institutions via a secured electronic format or delivered in person or mailed in a sealed envelope.
- If your transcript(s) are to be mailed, use the following address:

- If you are enrolled at the time of application, request a transcript showing any work prior to the current term to be sent before the CSU admission deadline, and also request one to be sent at the completion of the term.
