According to the 1920 Census, Claude Baldwin was 42 years old and a steam locomotive engineer and lived in Columbus, Georgia at 1347 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue with his wife and 4 children. By 1934 he was a superintendent with Central of Georgia Railroad.
