

Native American Dictionary Collection (MC 316)

Scope and Content

This Native American Dictionary Collection contains approximately 1650 slips, arranged alphabetically by the Creek term taken from the *Comparative Dictionary of Creek, Hitchiti, Alibama, Koasati, Choctaw, Yuchi, Natchez and Shawnee* compiled by General Albert Pike with additions by Mrs. E. A. Robinson. It consists of 1 text-sm box (.25 l.f.) with 16 folders.
