Scope and Content

This text-sm collection consists of stock certificates, receipts and a deed for lot 314 in Columbus. The majority of the materials have the name William B. Slade as a signature. He was a relative of the J. Rhodes Browne family. The materials are arranged chronologically within each folder . This collection was originally numbered MC 045 at the public library and renumbered MC 317 when the collection was donated to CSU Archives in the fall of 2013.
