

Alvin L. McLendon, Jr. Collection (SMC 11)

Organizational Note

Alvin L. McLendon was one of the original members of the faculty of Columbus Community College when it opened in 1959. It was the predecessor to Columbus College, which in turn became Columbus State University.

Scope and Content

This collection includes political materials relating to Democratic Party activities in Georgia in the 1910s. Dr. McLendon found them among his father's papers. Included are: Speech of Hoke Smith delivered in his debate with Clark Howell at Columbus, Georgia on January 10, 1906 Speech of Clark Howell, candidate for the Democratic nomination for Governor, delivered in his debate with Hoke Smith at Columbus, Georgia on January 10, 1906 Official Ballot, State Democratic Primary, Wednesday, August 22, 1906 Rules for holding the Georgia Democratic Primary on August 22, 1906, by the State Democratic Executive Committee at this meeting in Atlanta, Georgia on April 30, 1906 Address of the Honorable A.
