

Benning Herald Collection, SMC 148

Organizational Note

Fort Benning was originally established as Camp Benning during on October 7, 1918. On January 9, 1922, The War Department's General Order No. 1 made the camp a permanent military post and became known as Fort Benning. Today, Fort Benning currently has over 180,000 acres. The *Benning Herald* became the official publication for the base and consisted of news from around the base and military as well as Columbus.

Two editions of the *Benning Herald* published in March 1933 and February 1935.
