Financial Aid Options

- [Submit the your FAFSA](#) as early as possible.
 - CSU School Code = 001561
 - FAFSA is the application process for Federal Grants and Student Loans
 - FAFSA includes Fall through Summer (ex. Fall 2026 through Summer 2027)

Stay Eligible for Financial Aid

Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) for Federal Financial Aid

- 2.00 cumulative GPA (undergraduate), 3.00 cumulative GPA (graduate)
- 67% cumulative pace of progression
- 185 attempted hours maximum time frame (undergraduate)

Maintain HOPE Program Eligibility

- HOPE Scholarship - 3.00 cumulative GPA in college
- Zell Miller Scholarship - 3.30 cumulative GPA in college

Course Program of Study (CPOS) - Work with your Academic Advisor to ensure registered courses are within your program of study; financial aid cannot pay for courses outside of your program
