

Betweeners

- For groups of 3 or 4
- Each player rolls three or more dice and writes their values down. Using those digits, he/she decides the number combination he/she wants to create for that round.
- Players secretly record their own number on the top line of the score boxes.
- After all players have chosen & written their own number, they share their numbers and all players record on their own sheet. (“Vette” also writes Julie, Amanda and Betty’s numbers)
- The winner(s) of the round are the players whose numbers are NOT highest or lowest, but are BETWEEN.
- The winners of each round circle their numbers and play continues.
- The overall winner is the player with the most rounds won.
- If there are ties, the players share the win.
- When you finish, write about how your “between” numbers compared with others.

Example round for Vette: My 512 was > 243 and > 315 , but it was < 563 .
