In this puzzle, you'll have to do some detective work to correctly fill your tray with the 9 chocolate pieces: 3 strawberry, 3 chocolate, and 3 vanilla. Use the clues shown below to solve the challenge and test your logical deduction skills. There is only one correct way to place the pieces.

## Using the Clues

Each clue is a partial snapshot of a completed chocolate arrangement.
These clues fit only one way on the chocolate tray and therefore tell you exactly what part of the tray they refer to. However, these clues can fit in multiple places on the tray. You need to use logical deduction to determine the correct position.
Some clues may contain only a color or a shape reference. You may be able to combine a color clue and a shape clue to correctly identify where a piece belongs.

You may only get credit for solving one level: Advanced or Expert.
Advanced is worth 2 puzzle pieces, while Expert is worth 3 puzzle pieces. If you present both Advanced and Expert, you will forfeit credit for this task.
