Figure 1: Current Candidates in Counseling and Leadership Programs (2011-2012)



Figure 2: Male and Female Admittants and Program Candidates in Counseling and Leadership Programs (2011-2012)



Figure 3: Ethnic Breakdown (by overall percentage) of Program Candidates in Counseling and Leadership Programs (2011-2012)



Figure 4: Full- and Part-Time Candidates in the Counseling and Leadership Programs (2011-2012)




Figure 5: Percentage of Full- and Part-Time Candidates in Counseling and Leadership Programs (2011-2012)




Figure 7: Staff Results for Community Counseling (2011-2012)




Figure 9: Staffing Results for School Counseling (2011-2012)



Figure 10: Passage Rate for Community Counseling Exit Exam/First and Second Attempts (2011-2012)



