An active Tk20 account is a required resource for this course because selected assessments will be completed electronically using Watermark's Tk20 assessment system. Tk20 is a repository for university data that are collected for various purposes, such as demonstrating the quality of our academic programs, improving teaching and learning, and compiling data for national, state, and local reporting.

As a student, you will use Tk20 in a variety of ways, including submitting assignments, tracking field experiences, and completing portfolios of the work you have completed in your degree program. You also have the option to use your account for secure online storage of academic work and to share electronic portfolios or journals with prospective employers or other audiences.
