- Be an undergraduate student accepted for admission at Columbus State University
- Establish financial need as determined by the CSU Financial Aid Office.
  - Complete the 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) available at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). List CSU's code 001561.
  - (NOTE: If you are not eligible to submit your FAFSA online please complete the FAFSA: <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/options.htm>
- Be of proven Hispanic/Latino heritage, with family residing in the U.S.
- Be in good academic standing.
- Must agree to serve as an officer in **CHisPA** (**C**SU **H**ispanic **A**ssociation).
- Preference is given to students in the College of Education.
