The other letter should come from somebody who has worked closely with you in one of your activities and can attest to your service abilities, or potential for service. This person could be an employer, minister, volunteer coordinator, etc. Please ask the person providing this recommendation for you to return it to you so that you can include it with your packet by the deadline.

□ **PART V: Transcript**

Please provide a copy of your most recent transcript. This does not have to be an official transcript and can be a copy of your MyCSU record.
