#### **CALL FOR ART AND EXPRESSIONS**

The Counseling Center (Cougars End Suicide Initiative) is offering a suicide prevention program in collaboration with the Art Department during Spring semester of 2023. This program consists of a competition where students are invited to express their emotional journey through the arts. Participants' submissions will be displayed

on an online gallery. Images of the visual art and poetry submissions will also be reproduced on 4x4 panels to be displayed on vinyl murals throughout the CSU campus. This program will conclude with an event on March 13, 2023 from 12:00 PM - 1:30 PM entailing a speaker (TBD) followed by the distribution of prizes.

### The competition consists of five categories:

**Poetry/Story:** Participants will write a short poem or story on the topic. Maximum of 1000 words. File must be Word or PDF.

**Visual Art:** Participants will draw, paint, photograph or create a 3D Sculpture on the topic. Files must be in JPG format. Files may not exceed 5MB.

**Music:** Participants will record a 2-3-minute piece of music, or song on the topic. Audio Files may not exceed 5MB.

**Performance:** Participants will record a 2-3 minute short film on the topic. Performance can include acting and dance. MP4 Files may not exceed 25 MB.

**Slam Poetry/RAP:** Participants will record a 2-3 minute piece of slam poetry or RAP on the topic. Audio Files may not exceed 5MB.

#### **Rules**

- The Contest is open to all CSU students. Open to individuals only.
- All entries should reflect the theme of "Emotional Journey."
- All entries will be reviewed by a committee of judges.
- All entries must be original and free of copyright restrictions.
- Clear and legible entry forms must be included with each submission. Omission or illegibility may result in disqualification.
- Entry forms may be submitted prior to deadline. However, entries will not be considered complete until artwork is submitted. Fully completed entries must be submitted no later than March 6, 2023.
- Winners will be announced on March 13, 2023 during a suicide prevention event (location will be announced later).

# Columbus State, University System of Ga. Provide Students with New Career-planning Tool for Pre-, Post-Graduation Success

Thanks to the <u>University System of Georgia</u> (USG), Columbus State University students have access to a new career-planning tool that will provide them with additional career counseling services and connect them to information about graduates and alumni in the field in which they want to work. <u>The Career Resource Planning Platform</u> positions the system and its <u>26 public colleges and universities</u> as leaders in helping students with specific job services and career guidance—including potential degrees to pursue, job opportunities and salary ranges based on a student's interests.

USG is the first university system in the nation to work with an Atlanta-based data analytics company to implement the platform systemwide.
