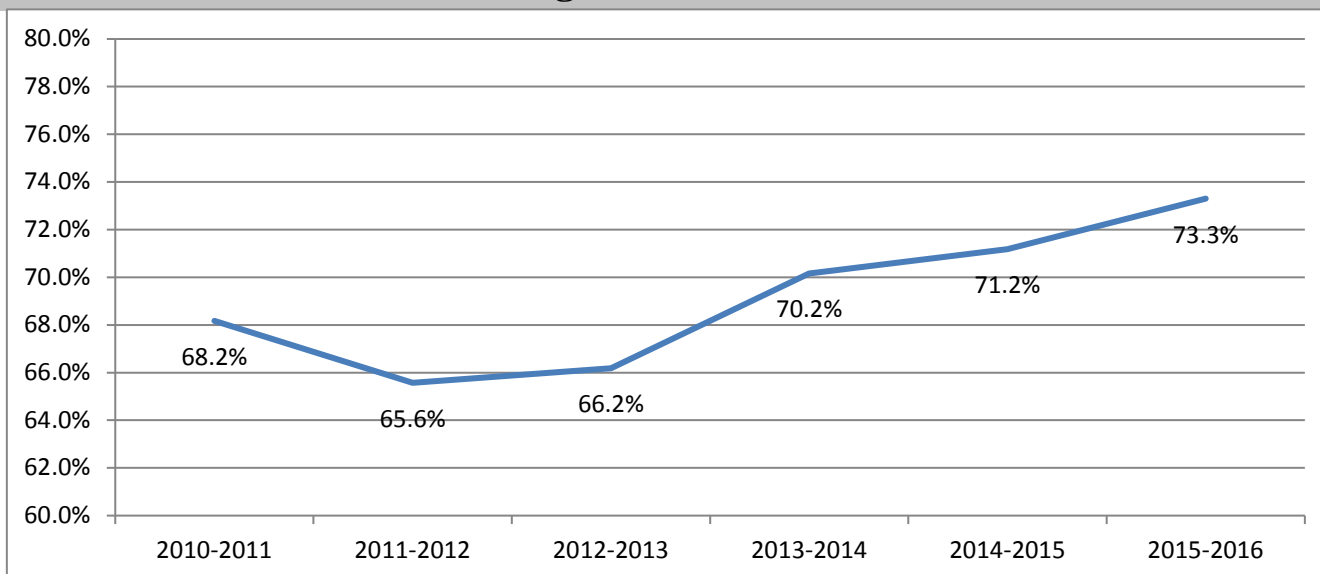


CSU Facts & Figures 2016: Retention Rates
