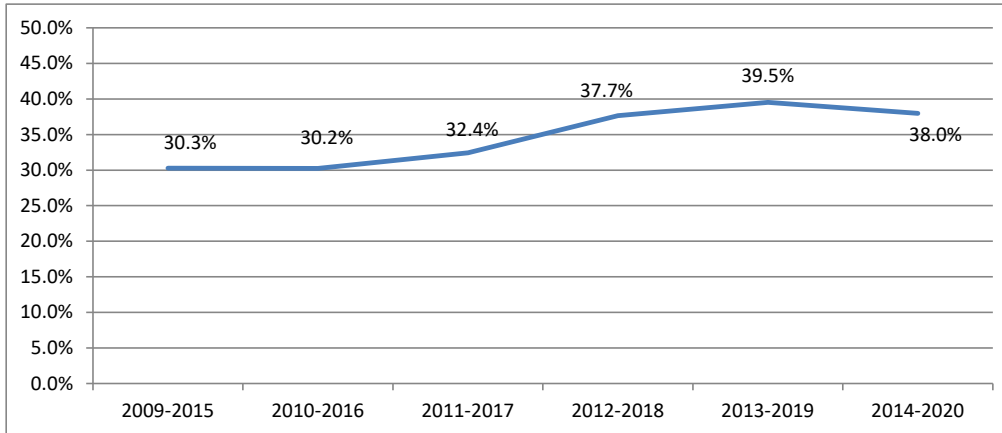


CSU Facts & Figures 2020: Graduation Rates
