

Diplomas Earned from Columbus College

Summary

Columbus State University was once Columbus College. CSU may issue a degree certificate to a graduate of Columbus College with the name Columbus State University.

Purpose

This document presents the guidance for issuing a degree certificate to a graduate of Columbus College with the name Columbus State University.

Policy

(From the BOR Policy Manual 3.8.5 Diplomas Earned at Institutions Under a Previous Name)

CSU may issue upon request a certificate to a graduate, who received a diploma under a Columbus College, with wording similar to the following:

“Be it known that (Student) _____, having received in the year _____, the degree of _____ from Columbus College, a predecessor of this institution, is hereby recognized as an [alumnus/alumna] of Columbus State University.”

This certificate will be signed by the president and appropriate dean of the institution concerned (BoR Minutes, 1965-66, p. 6).
