- **Report Suspicious Emails**
  - Use the [Phish Alert Button \(PAB\)](#) to report suspicious emails. This will allow UITS to analyze the email and take appropriate action.
- **Follow Information Security Policies & Standards**
  - Security controls exist to protect university systems and data. Bypassing them, even once, can introduce risk.
- **Protect Your Credentials**
  - Never share your password or multi-factor authentication codes, and do not approve unexpected login prompts. One approval is one too many.
