Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the program, an applicant must:

- Be a student enrolled at one of the partner institutions (Columbus State University, Columbus Technical College, Georgia Southwestern University, Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College or Valdosta State University)
- Pursue an associate or undergraduate degree in an LSAMP approved science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM) discipline
- Be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident with a documented qualifying condition
- Have a minimum 2.5 high school/college HOPE GPA or GED score 145



- Funding to supplement your education
- Become a member of a select community of undergraduate URM STEM scholars with access to a supportive network of professionals and mentors to help you achieve excellence in STEM courses and beyond in an environment that promotes inclusion in STEM
- Hands on STEM experiences that includes research training and participation in supervised research projects, interactions with STEM industries and URM STEM professionals to provide guidance and an understanding of what it takes to become a successful professional in STEM
- GRE preparation and guidance into graduate school, career planning and professional development activities that will outline a pathway towards your STEM career
