

# U.S. Army Captain Career Course

Columbus State University's transfer credit degree program with the U.S. Army Captain Career Course (CCC) provides pre-approved graduate transfer credit for CCC resident course graduates to transfer up to 9 credit hours. The credit can be applied to a master's degree program in Master of Public Administration (MPA), the Master of Science in Organizational Leadership (MSOL), Master of Science in Cybersecurity, or Master of Art in Strategic Communication. Earning your master's degree while enrolled in CCC is a fast way to advance your career.

## Enrollment Steps

- [Apply to CSU](#) - Indicate on your application your major and track. For example, list "CCC – Master of Science in Organizational Leadership Leader Development Track". Email your completed application to [military@columbusstate.edu](mailto:military@columbusstate.edu).
- **Submit Official Transcripts and supporting documents** - Official Transcripts can be emailed to [data\\_entry@columbusstate.edu](mailto:data_entry@columbusstate.edu)
- **Complete the Military Fee Waiver**
- **Application Fee - Waived**
- **Register for Classes** - Following acceptance, you will be connected with an Academic Advisor to assist you with registering for classes.
- **Utilizing Tuition Assistance** - If you are using Tuition Assistance for course(s), you will not be charged over the amount Tuition Assistance will cover per fiscal year (\$250 per credit hour up to 18 hours). Fees will be waived for all Active Duty less parking. Be sure to connect with the ESO at your Post's Education Center for approval and directions on creating your profile in ArmyIgnited. You will need to add your classes in ArmyIgnited 8-60 days prior to the start of the class.
