The **minor in audio technology** is a unique program designed to offer a rich set of experiences to music students, spanning a wide range of topics in music technology. Practical, hands-on experience is combined with the latest topics in the ever-growing world of music technologies. Students gain experience as recording engineers, live sound engineers, sound designers, composers, and researchers in this diverse field.

The Technology Area regularly interacts with all other areas of the Schwob School, and has provided support for everything from Jazz Ensemble and Wind Ensemble to Contemporary Ensemble.
