Kenneth Nance Nursing Scholarship

Purpose: The purpose of the Kenneth Nance Nursing Scholarship is to fund scholarships for nursing students based upon financial need, demonstrated leadership, and scholastic achievement. Funds may be used to cover expenses such as tuition, books, and other items necessary for a student's success and progression in the program.

Award:

- Three scholarships of \$1000 (\$500 fall /\$500 spring) to be awarded to three students who are selected for admission into the nursing program as an incoming junior level nursing student.
- Scholarship awarded during the first year of clinical nursing courses
- Application is required

Selection Process:

Students who meet the criteria for the scholarship will be notified via email and provided with an application. Selection of recipients for this award will be made by the Honors and Scholarship Committee.

Criteria:

1. Good standing in the School of Nursing / Columbus State University
2. Selected as an incoming junior level nursing student
3. Minimum 3.0 program GPA required
4. Demonstrates financial need
5. Demonstrates significant leadership and/or leadership potential
6. Demonstrates scholastic achievement

Applicants must:

1. Submit a completed application
2. Submit a resume
3. Submit a one to two page essay that demonstrates financial need, significant leadership and/or leadership potential, and scholastic achievement. Please sign and date your essay
4. Agree to assist and participate in School of Nursing's service opportunities

Submission Details:

Eligible students will be notified by June 1 and provided with an application. The application is due via email to the chair of the Honors and Scholarship Committee by June 17. *email address of chair will be included in the June 1 email
