**How to Apply**

Once a student has been fully admitted to Columbus State University and has their CSU email address and login credentials, they can begin the process of applying for on-campus housing!

Applying is simple and can be done by clicking [Apply Now for Housing](#) which will then redirect you to your MyHousing Portal. From there select the housing application under the subsection “Apply for Housing” and follow the guided steps.

Be sure to read all steps and contract information carefully before completing the entire application. Please be aware that for all new / first time residents living on campus, there is a \$200 application fee and a \$50 activity fee that must be paid upon completing the housing application.
