MEMORANDUM FOR Columbus State University ROTC Cadets

SUBJECT: Columbus State University ROTC Military History Policy

- 1. Reference. TRADOC Regulation 350-13, Military History and Heritage Education Program, 22 Feb 2018.
- 2. Purpose. To establish Columbus State University ROTC policy for satisfying the military history commissioning requirement.
- 3. Recognized Courses. All Columbus State University ROTC Cadets must take Introduction to US Military History (HIST 3146) offered by Columbus State University to satisfy the military history commissioning requirement.
- 4. Alternative Courses. Cadets are not authorized to take any alternative course to satisfy the military history commissioning requirement without the express written consent of the Professor of Military Science, which shall only be authorized for external situations outside the control of the Cadet.
