

RN-BSN Mobility Exam

Registered nurses applying for admission to the online RN-BSN completion program might be required to take this exam if their previous nursing program was not accredited by the NLN. This is a computer-based, 2-hour timed exam and no study guide will be provided. You may take the test a maximum of three times with at least 3 weeks between attempts.

Payment:

- **For in-person testing** at the CSU Testing Center: \$70. Payment is made online when you schedule your appointment.
- **For remote (online) testing** by ProctorU: \$100. Includes the ProctorU fee. If you schedule an appointment within 72 hours, ProctorU will charge you a late fee.

ID requirements: You must present an unexpired government-issued photo ID with signature--driver's license, passport, military ID, state ID. The first name and last name(s) on your identification must exactly match the first name and last name(s) on your CSU application.

Items needed for the test: We will provide you with scratch paper and pencil. Physical calculators are not permitted but a calculator is built into the test.
